107 athletes represented SFC this past spring in high school track & field. The Chargers continually sought to embrace and pursue the 3 C's of Christ, Community & Challenge. Following a great regular season, the month of May was filled with a number of remarkable performances for the Chargers. The boys and girls won 9 of the 10 relays at the Howard Wood Dakota Relays and went on to win the DAK XII Conference meet, Region 3A and had 48 athletes qualify for the State Meet, held in Sioux Falls. The boys and girls both finished the season as Class A STATE CHAMPIONS and claimed the Combined Team Title for Class A for the second year in a row.
