2026-2027 Re-Enrollment Due by March 31

Will your student be returning this fall? If so, please complete the re-enrollment process through the school's [JMC site](#) by March 31. Completing this process on time allows us to adequately plan for staffing and supplies for the upcoming school year.

The re-enrollment process includes:

- Answering standard enrollment questions
- Electronically signing two annual agreement forms

The office will process the required re-enrollment fees through your TADS Tuition account. Payments may be made by check, or will be processed according to your selected payment settings in TADS.

Re-enrollment Fee Schedule:

- \$75 per returning student through March 31
- \$100 per returning student beginning April 1
