New Website!

You may notice that our website has a new look. We are excited to have a more interactive and well-organized website to provide a clearer path for our families, staff and prospective families to access information and to communicate the mission and vision of SFC!

Our website address remains siouxfallschristian.org. There are some new ways of accessing information. **Key items to note:**

- On both desktop and mobile, you can quickly access the [Families](#) page (across the top on desktop, in the hamburger menu as an icon on mobile/desktop, as well as in the Key Links section). This contains the content that was previously under "My SFC > Current Families", including the weekly newsletter and lunch menus. You may want to bookmark this page!
- As you scroll down the front page, you will see a new section called **Key Links**. This is a newer element/trend that is being implemented by many schools and provides quick access to the most-visited pages or links on a school website. Our hope is that this will give you as parents easier access to items you use most often. This may change a bit seasonally.
- **JMC Student and JMC Parent log-ins** are found in the Key Links section and Families page.
- Right above the Key Links section, the **school calendar** is displayed on the front page, showing three days of events at a time. You can click on the "all events" button to access the full calendar. A link to the calendar is also located in the hamburger menu.
- The Athletics menu is now called "**Athletics and Clubs**", as we have a new page with information specific to club sports and school organizations. Individual athletic pages still display season schedules. These calendars can be synced to your personal online calendar.
- The **Fine Arts** section of the website has a main page called "[Arts](#)". This is the main location that contains the link to the full Fine Arts calendar and livestream.
- **Please delete any bookmarks** you may have from the old website as some links may have changed. You may need to refresh your page if you have our website currently pulled up on your phone or computer.
- Some updates are in process and redirecting links may take time. Thank you for your patience!
