# Things to Do Together to Foster Connections & Relationships:



### Put Technology to Work

Ask your grandchild to help you get started on the technology tools they are using. Once you get your accounts set up, your grandchild can teach you how to use them and you can more easily connect with each other.



#### Online Game

Sioux Falls Christian's mission to provide a Christ-centered excellent education, partnering with the church and home has led our school to continue to keep the **WHOLE STUDENT** in mind as we constantly strive to improve upon and deliver Christ-centered education.

#### WORKING TO PROVIDE

### MORE WHOLE-ISTIC EDUCATION

Aware of community needs, Sioux Falls Christian added **Pathways Literacy Center** to our campus. Pathways is unique to South Dakota and comes alongside students in need of specialized literacy assistance. Serving not only SFC students, Pathways has a large footprint on our Sioux Falls community with over 50% of its students from outside our school.

We also recently added **Breakthrough Christian Counseling & Alternative Education Center** to our campus as a deeper commitment to provide whole health to students and come alongside students and families during difficult times. Christian counseling and education alternatives are significant community needs, and we hope to grow Breakthrough beyond its current staff of three to reach more students and more families. Both Pathways and Breakthrough enhance Sioux Falls Christian's ability to reach more students and grow the Kingdom.

#### GROWING

#### TOWARD A GREENHOUSE

SFC hopes to have a Greenhouse on campus someday. A Greenhouse would be an effective tool to educate the whole student by **INVITING**, **NURTURING**, and **EMPOWERING** PK-12 students to more broadly participate in the growth cycle, steward resources, develop sustainability practices, and provide community benefits. We know a Greenhouse would facilitate beneficial educational, mental, physical, and spiritual growth opportunities for our students.





# plant science, ceramics, photography & marketing

FLEx stands for Formational Learning Experience.

Our Sioux Falls Christian campus has multiple FLEx projects occurring at any one time.

### SPRING PLANTS



This Spring, our Plant Science, Ceramics, Photography, and Marketing classes are working together in their studies. Students will plant, grow, create and market products that will benefit our community.

#### POTTERY

As they create beauty, study God's design and palette, and examine usage, Ceramics students will "throw" over 75 pots to use toward this project.

Exposing students to the life cycle of plants, the **order-discovering** intrinsic in plant life, the **beauty-creating** of growing plants, and the **neighbor-loving** of providing a community service, we will ultimately raise up our students to be **Christ-Treasurers**.

# Deep Hope

Our deep hope is that students will immerse themselves in God's beauty of creation and that they will connect their working with plants to the concept of sustaining healthy living.

Plants grown and pots created within this FLEx will be available for sale the 2nd week of May.

### PHASE 1: Equip

Goal: To provide strategic resources for healthy growth.

- High School addition of nine rooms and a gathering space
- Kirby STEM/FLEx Lab for PK-12th
- Kitchen efficiencies to handle growth

- Dedicated Pathways Literacy space
- Second Access Road
- · Early Childhood Center

Status: The Early Childhood Center remains to be funded and built. estimated cost \$5 million



### PHASE 2: Flourish

Goal: To live fully into God's calling on our lives.

- Fine Arts Facility to prompt lives of worship
- LG3 Impact Fund to facilitate our vision of Love, Grow, Go, and Glorify within our walls, on our streets, and in our world

Status: Fundraising for Phase 2 will begin when Phase 1 is complete.

#### PHASE 3: Steward

Goal: To ensure affordability and continued excellence.

Phase 3 is a \$25M Endowment that will provide for two areas critical to future sustainability: Professional Development and Variable Tuition

Status: Both current gifts and future gifts are welcome and encouraged.


The Together Campaign Endowment is a commitment to excellence, ensuring two critical components: keeping Christian education affordable and upholding a tradition of teaching excellence.

The power of endowed money is tremendous.



A \$25 million endowment, once funded, with a modest annual return of 5% would provide \$1,250,000 in annual revenue, while leaving the \$25M principal intact to grow and provide increased benefits.

We are seeking 100 Endowment Commitments by 2025.

Supporters can provide current or future gifts to our Endowment. Current gifts include cash, appreciated securities, charitable IRA rollovers, or other transfers of assets. Future gifts include gifts in a will or trust or designating Sioux Falls Christian as the beneficiary of a retirement plan or insurance policy.
